

HEALTH INSURANCE ASSISTANCE

Get Healthy! Get Insured! Open Enrollment for the Marketplace is November 1, 2016- January 31, 2017; however, it is still possible to enroll in the Affordable Care Act if you've had a major life change in the last 60 days, such as:

- Moving to a new residence
- Marriage
- Birth or adoption of a child
- Loss of health insurance through an employer or spouse's employer
- Divorce, which resulted in loss of health insurance

The fee for being uninsured in 2016 is the higher amount of \$695 per adult and \$347.50 per child or 2.5% of the annual household income (up to the penalty cap). People with no income or very low income may be exempt from paying the fee.

Rockbridge Area Health Center offers FREE in-person assistance to help with options through the Affordable Care Act as well as help with completing Medicaid applications, which are accepted throughout the year.
